UAE TEACHER LICENSEPREPARATIONS

Students will learn about the UAE teaching standards and the UAE's vision for the next 50 years in education. This includes specific expectations for all teachers to help implement a high-quality education system. Additionally, students will be introduced to the teaching license examination and will prepare for the exam.

ACADEMIC STUDIES PREPARATIONS (ASP)

The SEA ASP course combines individual and group activities to provide candidates with a strong set of skills necessary for success in educational settings. The course focuses on developing a comprehensive understanding and application of advanced communication techniques. It is worth 2 credit hours and is assessed on a pass/fail basis. A passing grade will help conditionally admitted candidates qualify for SEA postgraduate courses, although it does not count as postgraduate credit. THE MASTER OF EDUCATION IN TEACHER LEADERSHIP (M.ED. TEACHER LEADERSHIP)

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Expanding on the PGDE, this CAA-accredited program delves deeper into the fostering of scientific and innovative thinking in educational leadership. The program can be taken as a two-semester addition to the PGDE, or independently as a two-year (four-semester) program. The first year covers the PGDE curriculum, while the second year focuses on advanced research methods, contemporary educational psychology, and an "action research" thesis. The curriculum emphasizes research-based teaching practices and collaborative knowledge construction. Graduates will be equipped to lead educational innovations, influence policy, and promote the holistic development of their schools and communities.


